Instructions for New Graduate Students Health Exam

A. NTU Registration Procedure-Health Exam

- 1. <u>Fill out the "Online Health Survey"</u>: Please complete the "Health Survey for Graduates" during online registration. You will be able to log in with your NTU account to <u>myNTU</u> (<u>https://my.ntu.edu.tw/</u>) **after February 13, 2025**. Please find the <u>Health Survey for Graduate</u> icon in the Students area.
- 2. <u>Upload the "NTU General Health Exam Form" PDF file:</u>
 - i. Upload the full-colored completed "National Taiwan University International Students General Health Exam Form "scanned PDF file (the valid report period is within 3 months, from November 12 to February 17, 2025) to the Online Registration System.
 - ii. If the health exam report comes out after the registration period, please upload the examination fee payment receipt first and upload the completed form before March 17, 2025 to myNTU (https://my.ntu.edu.tw/) > Students > Health Survey for Graduate

B. Visa and Health Exams Hospital

- 1. If you hold a "Visitor Visa" and plan to apply for an ARC after entering Taiwan, it is recommended to visit the Family Medicine Division of <u>Taipei City Hospital</u> <u>Heping Branch</u>, the hospital designated to perform the health exam required while applying for an ARC(<u>Health Certificate for Residence Application</u>), nearest to the National Immigration Agency, to complete both the "<u>National Taiwan University International Students General Health Exam Form</u>" and the "<u>Health Certificate for Residence Application</u>".
- 2. If you have completed the "Health Certificate for Residence Application" required for your residence visa before arriving in Taiwan, please bring the completed Health Certificate for Residence Application with you when you go to NTU Hospital to complete the "National Taiwan University International Students General Health Exam Form"
- ★Note: NTU Hospital are not designated to perform the "Health Certificate for Residence

 Application". Please refer to the designated hospitals for the "Health Certificate for

 Residence Application" on the website of the Centers for Disease Control, Ministry of
 Health and Welfare:

^{*}Failure to complete points 1 and 2 will be regarded as incomplete registration procedures, and the **student ID card cannot be issued.**

C. NTU Hospital Appointment and Check-in Instruction

1. Please make an online appointment via the following link (no on-site registration provided):



- 2. Please fill out the "Personal Information" section (in the red box) of the <u>National Taiwan</u> University International Students General Health Exam Form in advance.
- 3. Please come to NTU Hospital (map) 2F Department of Family Medicine to check in according to the appointment date, from 8:30 am to 10:30 am and from 1:30 pm to 3:00 pm. The health exam usually takes 2 hours to complete.
- 4. Please fast for more than 8 hours and bring your passport or ARC and one 2-inch photo with you.
- 5. Examination Fee payment: You may pay the examination fee (NTD 900) on-site.
- 6. Fill out the "<u>Health Survey for Graduate</u>" during the online registration period, as stated at the beginning of this instruction (Point A1)

D. Examination Content

- 1. **Blood Test:** Fasting for 8 hours is required, including routine blood tests, liver and kidney function tests, uric acid levels, lipid profiles, and fasting blood sugar tests.
- 2. **Urine Test:** Midstream urine samples will be collected on the day of examination. For female participants with menstruation, please collect urine samples after three days of menstruation cessation.
- 3. **Chest X-ray:** Pregnant individuals should not undergo X-ray examinations. Please inform the staff at the Family Medicine Department registration desk. Remove items such as necklaces, metal buttons, and metal hooks from bras (upper-body clothing without metal does not require changing).
- 4. **Physical Examination:** Height, weight, visual acuity, and hearing tests will be conducted in the Family Medicine Department, followed by a consultation with a physician in the 5th clinic.

E. Health Exam Procedure:



Step 3 \sim 5 in the above procedure may be altered according to the health exam procedure of each examinee.

F. Please be aware of the notice below:

- 1. Please bring the "National Taiwan University International Students General Health Exam Form" provided by the University when attending the health exam. Fill in the details properly and register the results of the health exam. Please ensure that the form is stamped by the medical authority of the health exam, and upload the colored scanned copy of the health exam report to the Online Registration System. (10 working days will be required for the completion of the health exam report).
- 2. Wear comfortable and loose-fitting clothes on the day of the examination.
- 3. Participants wearing glasses must bring them on the day of examination for vision correction measurements.
- 4. If you are unable to complete blood tests, urine tests, or X-rays on the examination day, please complete them within one week after the examination day to avoid delaying the report collection time.
- If the health exam report comes out after the registration period, please upload the examination fee payment receipt first and upload the completed form before September
 13, 2024, to myNTU (https://my.ntu.edu.tw/) > Students > Health Survey for Graduate

G. How to get a Health report at NTU Hospital?

1. Pick up in person:

Please bring the receipt of the health exam when picking up the exam report at the Department of Family Medicine examination room.

You may come to NTU Hospital to pick it up from Monday to Friday \cdot 10 : 00 \sim 12 : 00 ; 14 : 30 \sim 16 : 00

2. Entrust someone else to pick up for you:

Please bring identification documents (ID card, ARC, or passport) for both parties and the examination payment receipt.

3. Entrust NTU hospital to post the Health report to you:

On the day of examination, provide a self-addressed standard envelope (attach an NT\$36 postage stamp for registered mail) with the recipient's information and address in Taiwan. NTU Hospital will mail the examination report to the provided address. (Postage stamps and envelopes are not available for sale at NTU Hospital. If you choose this method, please prepare a standard envelope with sufficient postage in advance.)
